

## Mooc Studying in France: intermediate French Level (B1 / B2)

This Mooc has a triple objective:

- to offer a course of French as a foreign language at intermediate level B1 / B2 to achieve the level required to take the courses taught in French in the higher education;
- to prepare international students for their studies in France by proposing an immersion in the contexts they will encounter in France;
- to promote the cultural and academic adaptation of international students

These objectives are linguistic, cultural and practical.

In the framework of the Ingenieur Polytechnicien Program, this Mooc Certificate of Achievement shall be required at the beginning of the academic program for the students who are already at B2 Level, and at the end of the first year for the others.
